



## **DANCE STUDIO TERMS & CONDITIONS**

### **FEES & PAYMENT**

1. Dance Fees are prorated into equal monthly payments starting September 2022 through May 2023, If you join our studio after September 1, 2022 your fees will be prorated into equal monthly payments starting the month after your initial enrollment.
2. Automatic Payments will process monthly on the same numerical date each month based on the date you set-up AutoPay, and must be between the 1<sup>st</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> of the month.
3. If you would like to opt out of AutoPay, manual payments are an additional \$15/month due to the added cost of manually invoicing and following up on payment with the student and/or parent. Personal checks, money orders, and exact cash are priced as manual payments and must be received by your first class of the month. Payments more than seven days overdue will be assessed a \$40 late fee.
4. You may pay for the season in full, which will not incur additional fees regardless of payment type.

### **ATTENDANCE & CANCELLATIONS**

5. The CFTA Dance Studio will be closed and classes will not meet on the following:
  - September 5 – Monday classes closed
  - October 31 – Monday classes closed
  - November 21-25 – Studio Closed for Thanksgiving
  - December 19-January 8 – Studio Closed for Christmas Break
  - March 13-17 Studio Closed for Spring Break
6. Recitals are Friday night and Saturday morning, April 28 & 29, 2023. Attendance at both recitals is required.
7. Refunds will not be issued due to student tardiness.
8. Refunds will not be issued due to missed classes.
9. Refunds will not be issued if a student is sent home due to illness or behavior.
10. To cancel your dance enrollment, notify the Center for the Arts at least 30 days in advance of your next payment due date.
11. If an instructor misses a class and a sub or make-up class is not provided, you will be refunded for that class session.
12. COVID-19 UPDATE: In the event of a shutdown due to COVID-19 or other widespread pandemic, lessons will automatically shift to virtual classes via Zoom/FaceTime/Skype. Students will still be required to put in a 30-day notice to stop classes and a refund will not be given for payments that have already been made up to that point. Our hope is that another shutdown is not required and we will do everything possible to provide a safe in-person lesson experience.
